Bishop Steven has extended the dispensation from the Mass obligation through Labor Day weekend, September 6, 2020. Please look at the full text of the Bishop's letter on the St. Joseph church website.

We will continue to have the two extra Sunday Masses during the month of July. Toward the end of July, we will re-evaluate.

Just as a reminder, everyone attending the 9:45 a.m. Sunday Mass is required to wear a mask. Please bring your own mask from home. At this Mass there will be no singing. Please follow the seating diagram at the entrances of the church. The Xs on the pews mark the places where you are not to sit. Communion will only be given in the hand at the regular Communion time for now. However, after the final blessing and/or final hymn, I will be available to give Communion on the tongue for those who wish it.

Friday, July 3rd, is First Friday and we will have Adoration at 11:00 a.m., followed by Benediction at noon.

The parish office and church will be closed on Monday, July 6th. The church will be locked after the 7:00 a.m. Mass.
