Immaculate Conception is on Tuesday, December 8th. It is a Holy Day of Obligation and we will have two Masses – one at 7:00 a.m. and one at 7:00 p.m. The Holy Family School Mass at 9:00 a.m. is open only to students, teachers and staff.

There will be a special Advent confession opportunity on Thursday, December 10th from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

For those of you who have not returned to church yet, you are missed. I miss you and am looking forward to the day when we all feel safe and are back together. If you are thinking about returning to church, the Saturday 5:00 p.m. and the Sunday 5:00 p.m. Masses are not full. There is plenty of space to be socially distant.

Although I encourage everyone to wear a mask, please note that you must wear a mask at the 11:15 a.m. Sunday Mass. Remember that the two center sections of the church are reserved for families.

We will have four Christmas Masses this year: Two Christmas Eve Family Masses, one at 4:00 p.m. and one at 6:00 p.m., Christmas Eve Mass at midnight and Christmas Day Mass at 9:00 a.m. If you plan to attend one of the Christmas Eve Family Masses, please call the parish office to reserve your place – we are limiting the number to 150 at each Mass. You will be required to wear a mask at all the Christmas Masses.
