### CHURCH'S VIEW ON CREMATION

In 1963, the Church issued guidance on cremation and the burial of the cremains. Permission for cremation was incorporated into Canon Law of 1983 (Canon #1176) as well as into the Order of Christian Funerals.

The Bishops of the United States and Holy See have now authorized the celebration of a Catholic Funeral Liturgy with the cremains when the body is cremated before the funeral. The church then encourages placement of the cremains in a final resting place.


The final resting place may be burial in a traditional cemetery plot, or in a columbarium niche.

# **COLUMBARIUM**

The Columbarium will provide a prayerful, private, and beautiful site on the parish grounds for the permanent place of rest and remembrance for our departed loved ones.

Displaying the Station of the Cross on each pillar surrounding the Columbarium will add a visual opportunity for meditation on the life of Jesus and his promise of eternal life.

Each Station will be embedded into one of 15 pillars along the perimeter of the Columbarium grounds.

# **COLUMBARIUM TIMELINE**

**October 2020**: Site preparation began with the demolition of the building that had been used as religious education classes; as a rectory; and as recently as 2017, the convent.

**November 2020**: Received permission from the Bishop to proceed with the construction of the Columbarium.

### January 2021: Groundbreaking

May 15, 2021: Beatification in Rome of Father Francis Mary of the Cross Jordan

Summer, 2021: Columbarium Dedication

## What is this Initial Naming Selection?

### What is the cost for each Station?

For a LIMITED TIME, the amount is discounted to \$9,000 until the Beatification ceremony in Rome of Fr. Francis Mary of the Cross Jordan on **May 15, 2021**; the price will revert to the standard \$10,000 per Station after the columbarium dedication.
